

**Ridgebury Township
Supervisors' Meeting
March 4, 2009**

Sup. Ostrander called the Supervisors Meeting to order a 7 pm at the Ridgebury Township Municipal Building, 13278 Berwick Turnpike Gillett, PA. He led those in attendance to a pledge to the flag. Members Present: Lawrence Ostrander and Gary Wood. Absent: James Allen. Announcement of recording: Jerry Rightmire and Township.

Citizens Input

- Pat Scala – Questions in regard to credit card charges and the Sunset Drive complaint. Secretary explained the credit card charges for the PSATs Convention. Secretary will follow up with DEP in regard to Sunset Drive complaint.

Meeting Minutes

- Sup. Wood made a motion to accept the minutes of the February 4, 2009 Supervisors Meeting, seconded by Sup. Ostrander, motion carried.

Treasurers Report

- Sup. Ostrander made a motion to accept the Treasurers Report and pay bills, seconded by Sup. Wood, motion carried.

Reports

- Auditor Judy Walsh reviewed the Annual Auditors Report.
- The Road and Police Reports were reviewed.
- Kathy Joe Minnick reviewed the Park Committee Report. Cow Pie Bingo fundraiser is being planned for June 6, 2009. Volunteers are needed for the Park Committee and the fundraiser.
- Code Inspections Report was reviewed.

Correspondence & Communications

- Archer Complaint – In regard to DEP violation, Secretary will follow-up on this.
- Loader Case – Determination from PA Commonwealth Court ruling there was no loss to the Township.
- High Hazard Dam correspondence H20PA Act Funding received from DEP, Atty Lantz and Rep. Matt Baker was reviewed.
- Flood Summit – April 24. Secretary will enroll Sup. Wood and Ostrander for this, she will follow-up with Sup. Allen.
- Dirt and Gravel Roads meeting – March 19th – Secretary will enroll Sup. Ostrander and Leland Stringham, she will follow-up with Sup. Allen and the other two road crew.

Old Business

- Bids Sup. Wood made a motion to advertise the following for bid:
 - Road Material: At least 2000 yards end product crushed gravel using impact crusher to be crushed and stored at your location, not to exceed 12 miles from the Township's Municipal Garage. Stone should be 1.5 inch minus in size. And 45 yards more or less IRC to be stockpiled at the Ridgebury Township Garage.
 - Cinders: Delivery of 1,500 ton more or less of PennDot approved anti-skid cinders to be stockpiled at the Township Garage.

- Fuel: 6,000 gallons more or less of low sulfur diesel fuel and 1,500 gallons more or less of 86 Oct NL gas to be delivered to the Township garage as needed during the year of 2009.

Seconded by Sup. Ostrander, motion carried.

- No Winter Maintenance Roads – Supervisors discussed how the township would handle the plowing of no winter maintenance roads. At this point the Township will handle as they always have, which is doing winter maintenance on these roads when requested by a property owner for access.
- Road Bonding – Secretary to meet with another Township to gather information in regard to bonding the Township roads.

New Business

- Spring Clean-up – Sup. Ostrander made a motion to hold Spring Cleanup on May 9 from 7 am to 12 pm and for the Secretary to advertise as such, seconded by Sup. Wood, motion carried.
- Road Inspection – Sup. Ostrander made a motion to hold Spring Road Inspection on April 14th at 7 am and for the Secretary to advertise as such, seconded by Sup. Wood, motion carried.
- Resolution 2009-05 Internet Bidding – Sup. Wood made a motion to pass Resolution 2009-05-Internet Bidding to enable the Township to place equipment online for bid, Secretary to register the Township-pay \$200 annual fee and place equipment online, if necessary place another legal ad in the paper, seconded by Sup. Ostrander, motion carried.

Sup. Ostrander opened the meeting for any additional questions or comments.

Sup. Wood made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Sup. Ostrander, motion carried.
