- Campbell/Fuller Memorial - Descendants of first settlers of Bentley Creek. They will be placing a monument at the Park on July 9, at 7 pm. Sup. Allen made a motion allowing memorial to be placed by flag pole in park, seconded by Sup. Ostrander, motion carried.

- Tax Exonerations – Sup. Allen made a motion to approve the 3 Tax Exonerations, seconded by Sup. Ostrander, motion carried.
