

Ridgebury Township Supervisors' Meeting
April 14, 2009

Sup. Ostrander called the Supervisors Special Meeting to order at 3:30 pm at the Ridgebury Township Municipal Building, 13278 Berwick Turnpike Gillett, PA. He led those in attendance to a pledge to the flag. Members Present: Lawrence Ostrander, Gary Wood, James Allen.
Announcement of recording: Township, Jerry Rightmire, Mike Rinebold.

Citizens Input

- Jerry Rightmire – Questions and discussion in regard to PennDot closing Berwick Turnpike for bridge repair. Supervisors responded that the Township is doing a petition and requesting a meeting.
- Bob Galvin – Hold questions until the Dam correspondence is discussed.
- Mike Rinebold – Questioned when the petition was going to be done and where it was going to be placed. Supervisors responded it was being done as soon as possible, putting them everywhere we can.

Correspondence & Communications

- Court Order – Notice was given by Judge Smith that an argument in regard to the Township's Motion to Vacate the court order of January 21, 2008 would be held on May 8 at 8:30 am. Discussion continued in regard to this.

Old Business

- Gravel Bid: Tabled from previous meeting, three bids that were received for: At least 2000 yards end product crushed gravel using impact crusher to be crushed and stored at your location, not to exceed 12 miles from the Township's Municipal Garage. Stone should be 1.5 inch minus in size. And 45 yards more or less 1RC to be stockpiled at the Ridgebury Township Garage. Three bids were received:
 - i. Cole Construction: \$4.75/ton crushed gravel \$12.00 ton/1RC
 - ii. Porters: \$8.00 ton/crushed gravel \$10.75 ton/1RC
 - iii. Gerould: \$9.25 yard/crushed gravel \$18.00 yard/1RCSup. Allen made a motion to accept the bids from Cole Construction, seconded by Sup. Wood, motion carried.
- Road Bonding – Discussion was held in regard to posting/bonding Township roads and other options available. Sup. Allen will follow up with Commission Smith to find out about an Information Meeting that is going to be held.
- DeCristo Sub-Division – Sup. Allen made a motion to approve the DeCristo Sub-Division, seconded by Sup. Wood, motion carried.
